

TOXIC SUBSTANCE CONTROL ACT  
"TSCA"

One of the below declarations is required to be completed, and signed prior to customs releasing your cargo. The certification should be placed on your own letterhead, if it is not on the customs invoice supplied by the shipper. (it is not)

Since U.S. Customs does not regulate the importation of these products, they can not answer questions regarding TSCA. Customs simply acts as a monitor for the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) who regulates toxic substances. You must contact the EPA if you have questions regarding the TSCA.
